Best Fish: Sparrow with a salmon weighing in at 1.894kg


Biggest Fish: Barry with a whiting of 0.433kg




Baz and his 'broken trophy' for biggest fish

- ☺ **Happy birthday** to the August babies: Andrew B, Barry B, Bill B & Ben T


- ☺ **FACT:** The only mammals to undergo menopause are elephants, humpback whales, and human females!
