## ***From the Office***

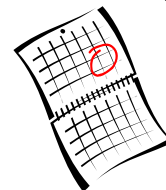

**Best Fish: Rob** with a 2.138 Drummer

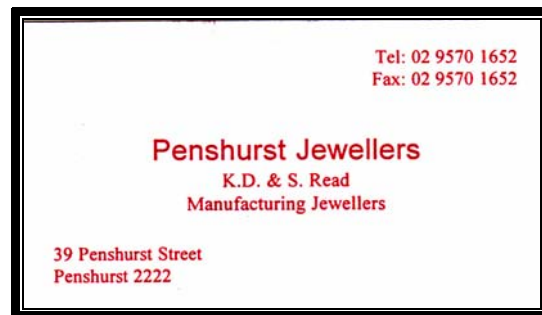
**Biggest Fish: Justin** with a Groper of 2.1kg

The **Vic Raffle** was won by the Pres with ticket # 62.



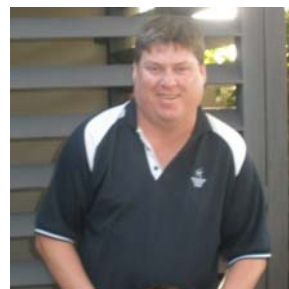

JB: Biggest

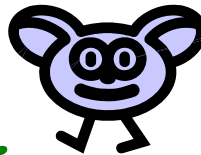
