





FISH OF THE MONTH (AUGUST) TUNA

Tuna is a saltwater finfish that belongs to the tribe Thunnini, a sub-grouping of the Mackerel family — which together with tunas, also includes bonitos, mackerels & Spanish mackerels.

A little history on our records for Tuna.

Albacore – 8.1kg recorded April 1994 Blue Fin – 7.8kg recorded October 1991 Mackeral – 6.880kg recorded June 1999 Striped – 6.8kg recorded November 1990 Yellow Fin – 46.0kg recorded April 1997

As can be seen, it has been a number of years since a record tuna has been caught, maybe this is the year!




